Instructions to Bidders

The Board of Fire Commissioners of the Benton County Fire District 6 has declared the following miscellaneous property surplus to the needs of the District and offer for sale in accordance with applicable law.

- Surplus property may be viewed, and bids will be accepted on Friday, June 21st from 9 am to 3 pm. Some items will be priced per piece and may be purchased outright. Larger surplus items will be placed in lots and individuals may submit a bid during the bid period. After 3pm bids will be reviewed, and the successful bidder will be notified. Bidders need not be present at the time of the bid opening to be awarded the items.
- 2. The surplus property is detailed on the attached list and may be inspected by prospective bidders prior to bidding.
- 3. The bid for property items is best offer above the minimum requested (if applicable).
- 4. Bids shall be submitted on a District form and placed in bid boxes assigned to the individual lots. Bid boxes will be opened on the day of the sale after 3pm.
- 5. Bidders will be notified of the award on the day of the sale. Acceptance of a bid award shall constitute a confirmed and completed sale of the subject property to the bidder who then becomes the purchaser. The purchaser shall be immediately vested with ownership of the property upon receipt of payment by the District, at which point Fire District 6 shall have no further interest in, or liability for, the subject property.
- 6. The surplus property will be available to the purchaser at the District's facility, at a time to be arranged between the purchaser and the Fire Chief after the acceptance of the bid. The successful bidder shall present a payment for 100% of the amount bid upon receipt of surplus property.
- 7. All surplus property is sold "as is, where is" without a warranty of any kind, and without any statement or implicating of condition, fitness for purpose or service life.
- 8. Purchaser of any surplus property assumes full liability for its condition and use and by placement of a bid, agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Benton County Fire District 6 from any liabilities or costs that arise out of the purchase or use of any surplus property
- 9. The submittal of a bid shall constitute acceptance of these Instructions to Bidder.
